¿Cuándo usamos "going to"?

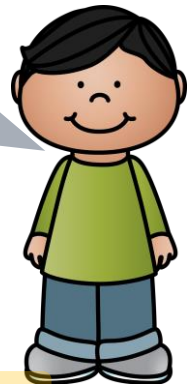
Lo usamos para hablar de planes, de algo que has decidido o sabes que **vas a hacer** en el futuro.
